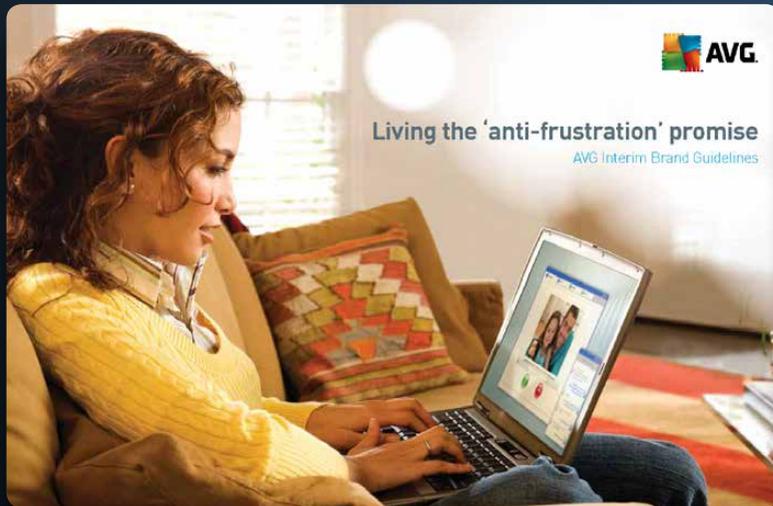

AVG is a disruptive software company that pioneered the freemium business model online. With 140 million users and growing, the AVG brand is globally recognised.

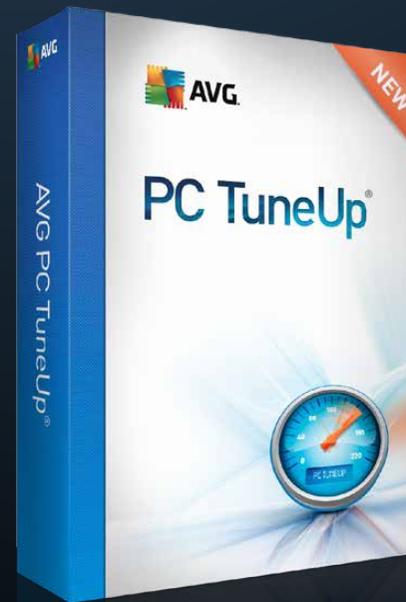
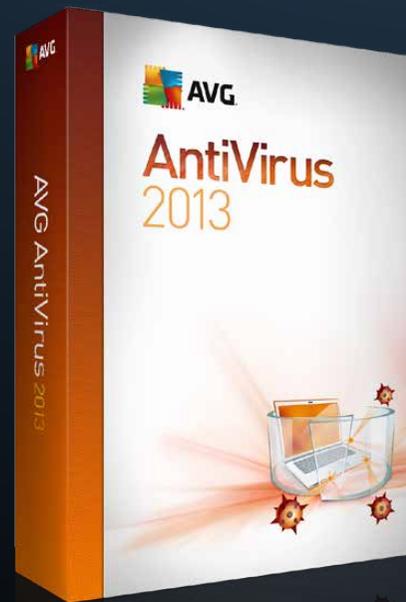
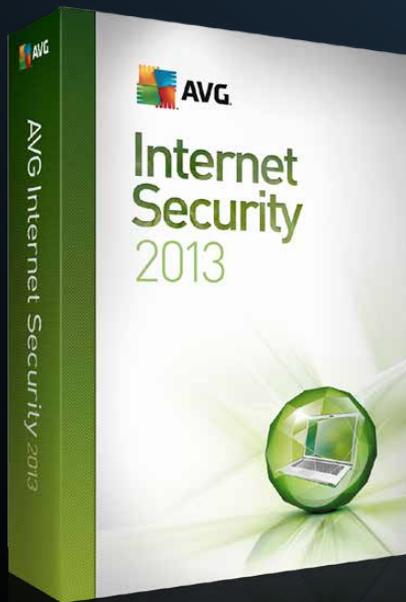

Details

With the launch of the 2013 product range came a new focus on the use of technology in every day life.

On request from our largest German reseller, I took a brief for a series of magazine ads to be run in a series of German technology magazines.

I handled the project from creative direction to creative execution, offering a range of concepts that answered to the brief, highlighting benefits of specific products that are relevant to the tech-savvy target audience.

On agreeing the creatives to move forward with, I produced final print ready artwork for each concept.

These concepts generated excitement from our other global retailers, and so I prepared source files to be localised by local agencies. Everything down to the name on the bank card was left open to be localized in any given market.

Producing and distributing these and similar campaign creative assets globally has increased consistency of advertising in smaller local regions, saving the business money, and helping to replace dubious, low cost local production of advertising materials.

Our task was to give Monster.com a fresh look and feel, while bringing the user experience up to date and beyond that of current competitors in the market.

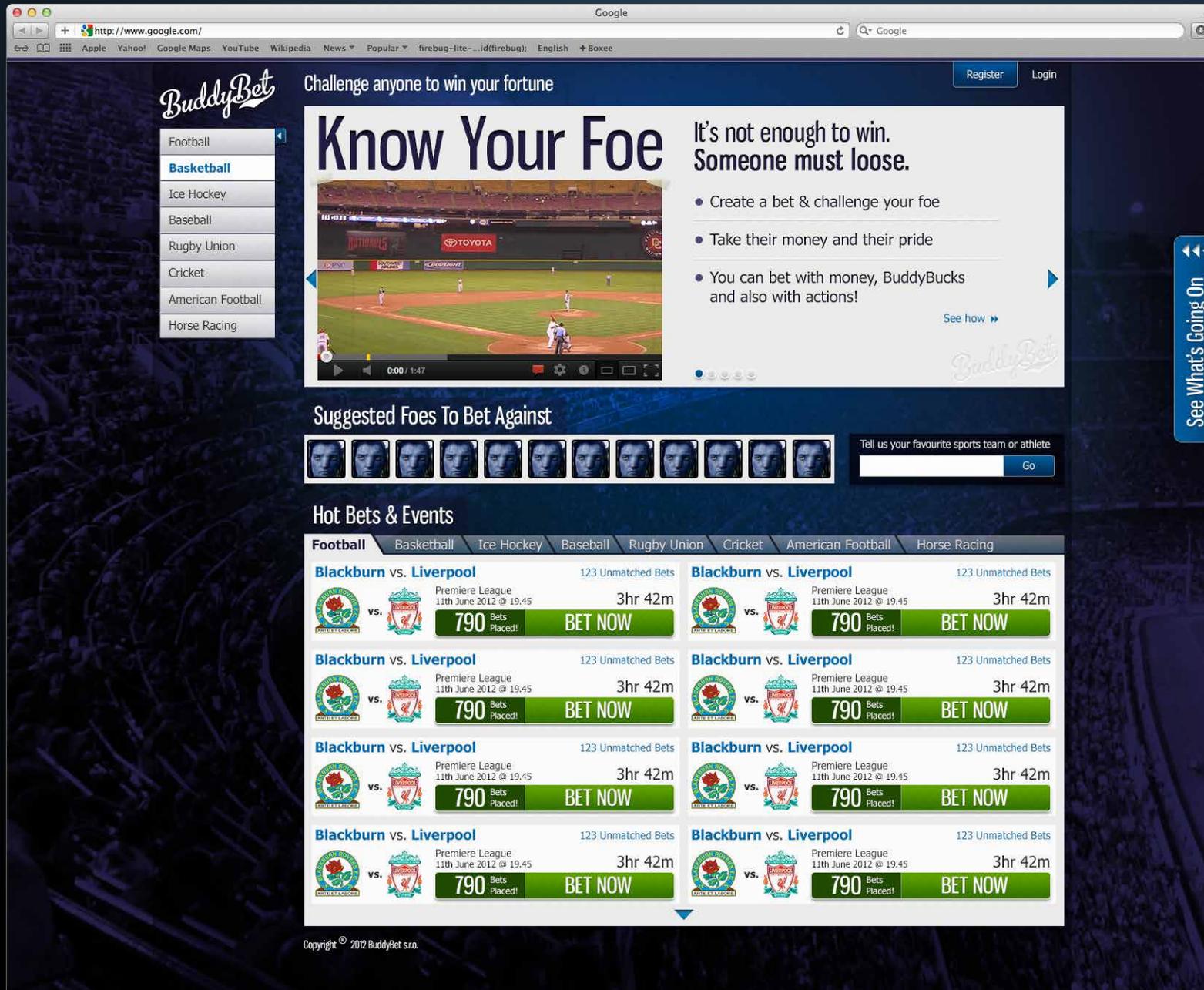

## BuddyBet.com - know your foe



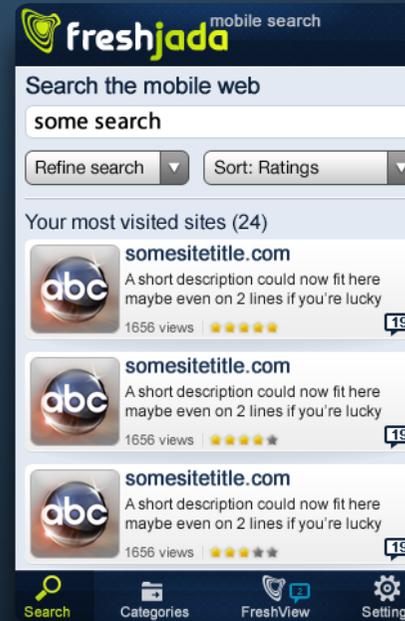
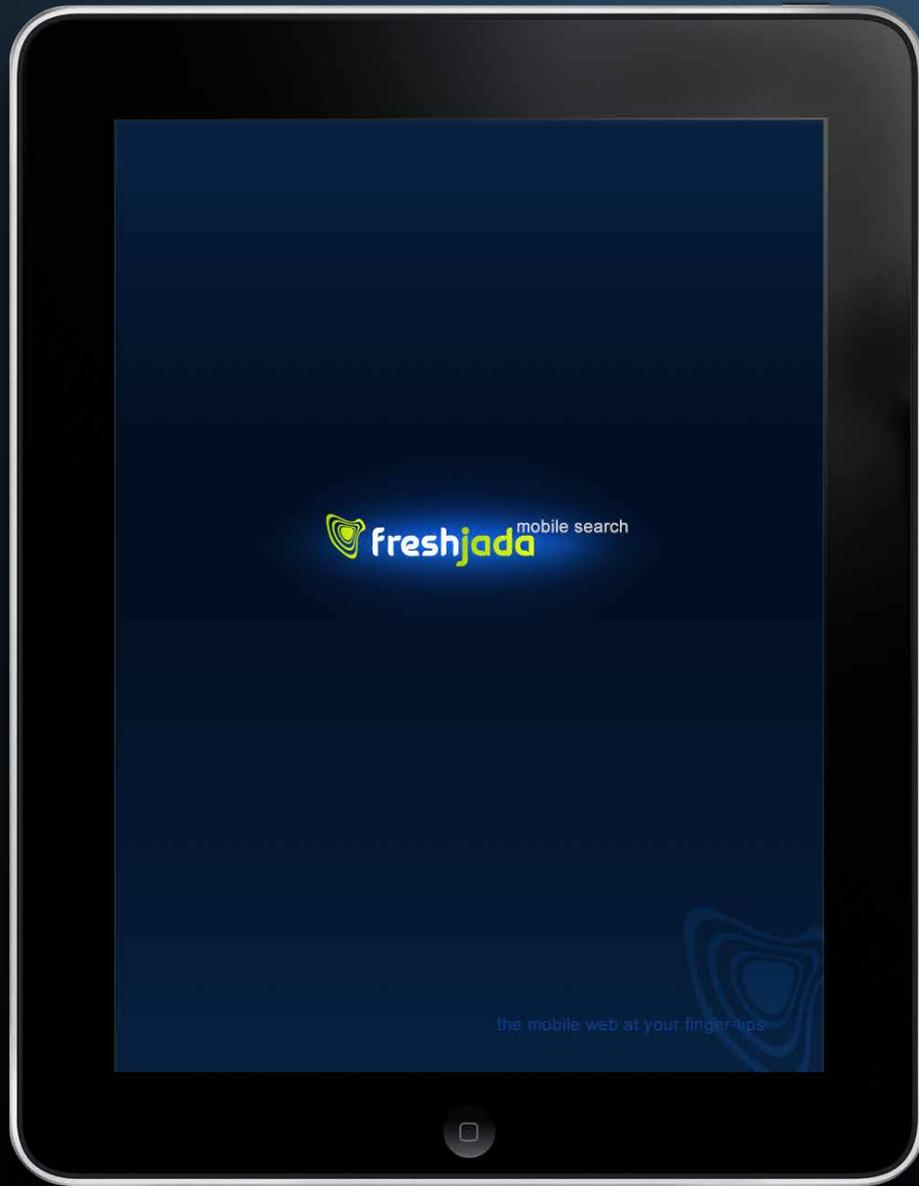
## Details

## FreshJada - mobile search app for iOS

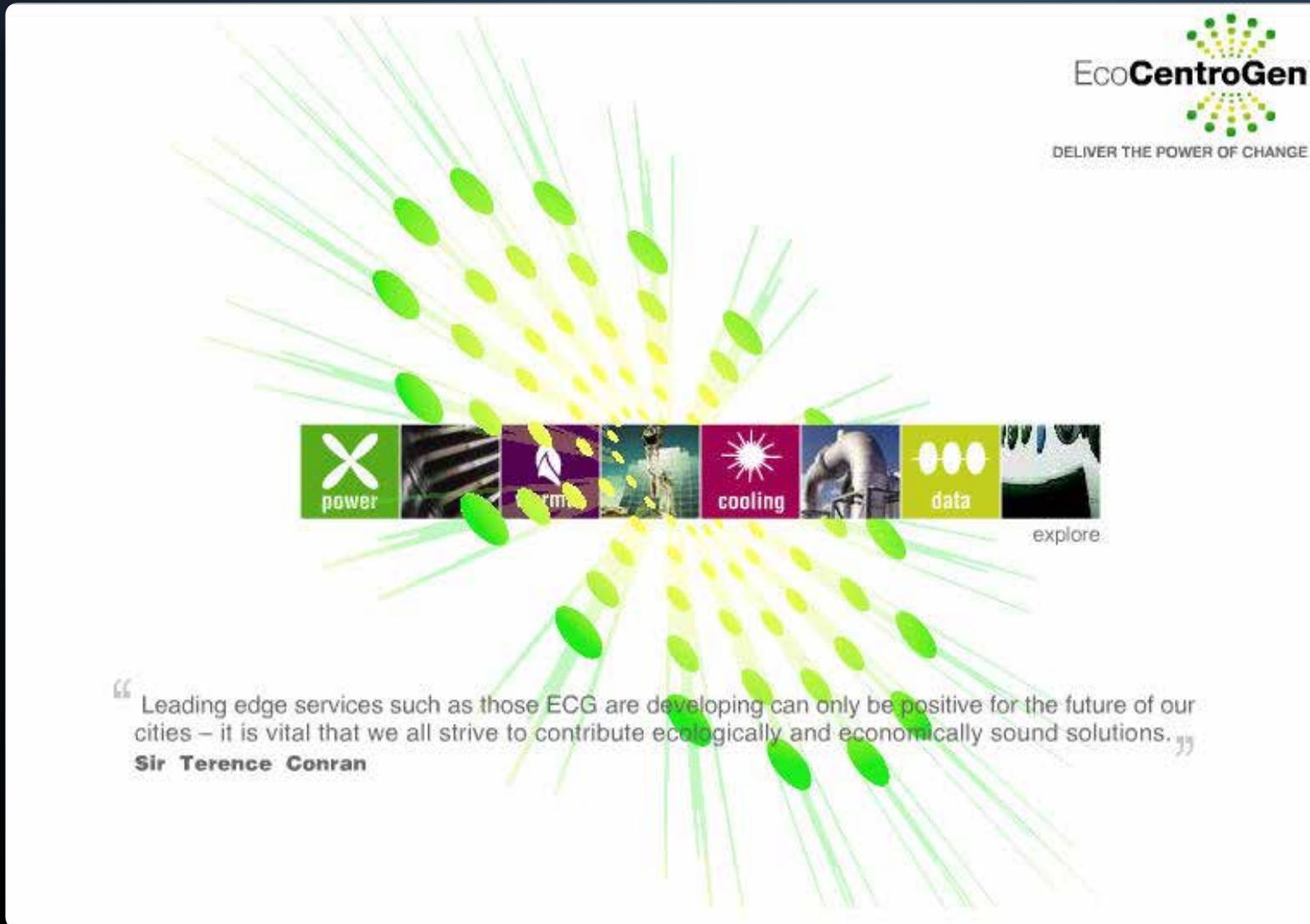


## Details

ecocentrogen is a London company specialising in power and amenity solutions for housing development projects.

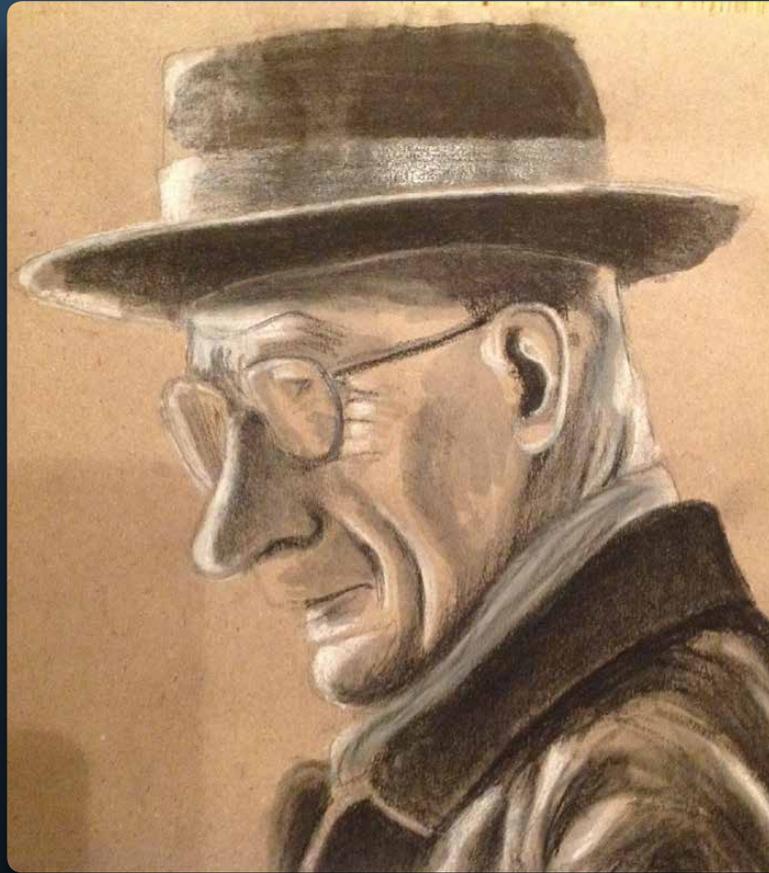
As a new media designer at Symbius in the UK, I was tasked to create something cool and environmentally positive to reflect the ecoCentroGen branding and ethos.

## Axxia Exhibition Stand



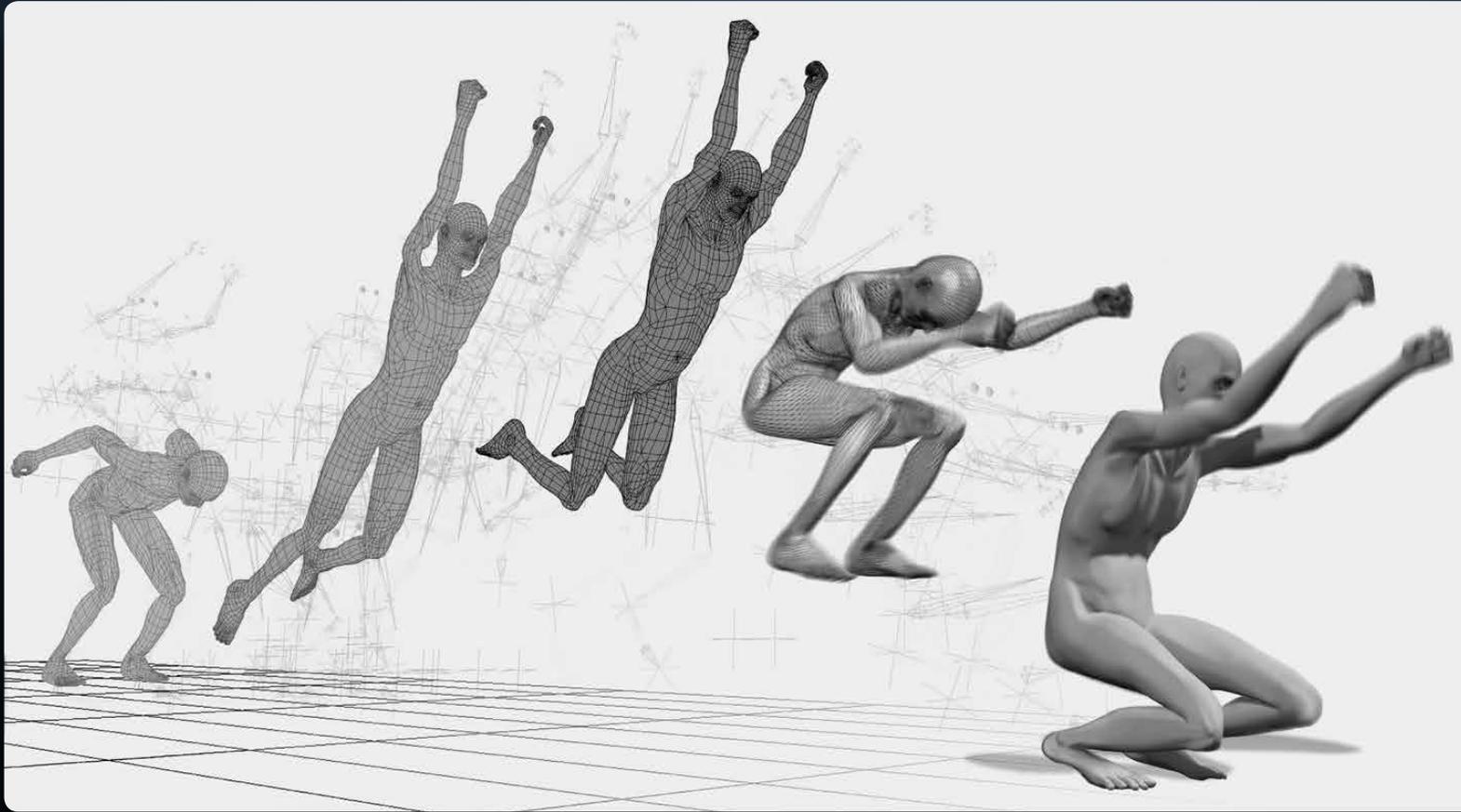
## Details

This visual for Axxia International exhibition stand was generated entirely in 3D from architect drawings produced by John Quatermaine at Future Events, London England.

I generated the visuals to aid John's client understand how their finished stand would look, the location and scale of graphics and elements on the stand and the technology requirements to consider when placing equipment within the space.

With experience in the exhibition industry from a young age (Oasis Graphics, Wooburn Green, 1996-1999) I can appreciate the real requirements of an exhibition stand design, and through my skills in 3D modelling and lighting can achieve very realistic results.

## Details

Having studied and specialized in 3D modelling and animation at university, I have a good eye for surface effects, lighting and rendering.

Although I don't do so much 3D lately, my eye for lighting, shading, detail and composition is still finely tuned, and I use it daily when composing or critiquing creative work to judge realism, shadowing, proportion or other visual details.

Often times I notice details that others, often marketing managers, wouldn't have seen otherwise, or they feel that nobody else would ever see them, so best not worry about them!
